Please make sure that you are aware of the bump in procedures and timelines, if you need assistance on the day there will be plenty of staff wearing high vis vest and they will be able to assist you.

5.00 am	ROAD CLOSURE	<ul> <li>Glenferrie Road is Closed to all through traffic between Burwood and Barkers Roads</li> <li>All Side Streets entering Glenferrie Road are now closed at Glenferrie Road</li> <li>Exit from Liddiard St or Burwood Rd</li> </ul>	
	ACCESS	<ul> <li>Access on to Glenferrie Road is now only available via Barkers Road</li> <li>Businesses can still access their parking at the back of their premis by using side streets (enter via Power St or Auburn Rd)</li> <li>Exit from Liddiard St or Burwood Rd</li> <li>Speed Limit 20kph</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>All deliveries and dropoffs between 5am and 9.30am must be made via Barkers Rd</li> <li>Exit from Liddiard St or Burwood Rd</li> <li>Speed Limit 20kph</li> </ul>	
	RIDES & INFRASTRUCTURE	<ul> <li>Traffic Management have road barriers in place from 3:00am</li> <li>Ride Set Up from 5.00am</li> <li>Astro Turf Set Up from 5.00am</li> <li>Marquee Set Up from 5.30am</li> <li>Hostile Road Barriers from 5:30am</li> <li>Picket Fence delivered from 6.00am</li> <li>Tables, Chairs etc deliver from 6.00am</li> </ul>	
7.30 am	STALL SET UP	<ul> <li>All stalls can begin set</li> <li>Entry must be from Barkers Road</li> <li>Exit must be from Liddiard St or Burwood Rd</li> <li>Drop all equipment at site and remove car prior to set up to keep Glenferrie Road Clear</li> <li>No Vehicle is to be left unattended at any time</li> <li>Speed Limit 20kph</li> <li>Be aware of trip hazards while setting up, both avoiding them and creating them.</li> <li>This is the busiest time of the morning, leave room for other vehicles to pass</li> </ul>	
9.00 am	FEATURES	<ul> <li>Animal farm arrive and set up</li> <li>Performers can access site and green room</li> </ul>	

9.30 am	ROAD CLOSED TO ALL VEHICLES	All Vehicles Must be removed from Glenferrie Road at 9.30am
11.00 am	FESTIVAL OPENS	<ul> <li>The Glenferrie festival officially opens</li> <li>As the festival is an outdoor event and supermarkets and other services are open before 11:00 AM, visitors may already be on Glenferrie Road, and you could start receiving customers earlier than the official start time</li> </ul>
5.00pm	FESTIVAL CLOSED	<ul> <li>The Glenferrie Festival has officially concluded.</li> <li>Stallholders should cease trading and begin packing down their stalls.</li> <li>Vehicle access to Glenferrie Road is expected to commence at 5:30 PM.</li> <li>Bump-out will continue until 7:00 PM.</li> <li>Please pack up your stand promptly.</li> <li>Hired equipment and furniture will be collected; ensure all marketing materials are removed from trestle tables and marquees.</li> </ul>
6:00 pm	CLEANING	<ul><li>Bins collected</li><li>Street sweeper commences at 6:30pm</li></ul>
7.00pm	STREET RE-OPENS	Glenferrie Road officially handed back to council

## **Bump Out- Pack up Glenferrie Festival 2025**

Bump out timeframes are short, so please make sure you start packing up at 5pm so we can meet our timelines. Bump Out for all zones is between 5pm to 7pm.

You will not be able to leave the festival site prior to 5pm

Once it is **5pm** you will be able to start to pack up. Once your packup is complete you will be able to bring vehicles on the street via Barkers Road, Liddiard Street. All other streets will be closed until **7pm** 

- This is a tight time frame so we ask you to assist us with the bump out. This is a community street festival we can not afford to be paying fines for not having the street ready to hand over to the Council and PTV at 7pm
- Remember at all times that an emergency vehicle must be able to get down the street during Bump Out.
- No cars are to be left unattended at your site during Bump Out
- Speed Limit during **BUMP OUT** is **20 km/per hour** with vehicle's hazard lights on there will be pedestrians on the street
- Do not double park vehicles in front of stalls during Bump Out.
- Remove all rubbish from the site. This event is funded by the Glenferrie Traders Association, if the Event Management determines that you have left your site in an unsatisfactory state at the end of the Festival. i.e rubbish left behind,including but not limited to zip/cable ties left behind, pamphlets or flyers you will be charged \$850 minimum fee for cleaning of your site.

Exit points for bump out once your bump out is complete are Burwood Road, or Liddiard Street
